This guide explains how to get to the Lynton Hotel from London's airports, train stations and our local coach, train and tube station.

Each destination is described on a separate sheet so that you only need to print the pages that relate to your own journey.

The Lynton Hotel is just a few minutes walk from Victoria train and tube station. And is less than 1 minute walk from Victoria coach station. Therefore, all of the travel sheets explain how to get to one of these two locations. You can then use the instructions at the start of this guide to walk the rest of the way, or you can take a taxi (approximately £5) if your bags are heavy.

We have included approximate costs, times and useful information.

If you will be travelling to us by a method not described in this guide, please call us and we will do our best to help.

How to get to the Lynton Hotel from Victoria Coach, Train and Tube stations.



The Lynton Hotel

General

This sheet shows how to get to us from our local train, coach and tube stations. Therefore, please be sure to print off this sheet.

Directions from Victoria coach station.

Leave the bus station by main exit walking pass a pub on your right hand side called the Travellers Inn . Once in Elizabeth Street you turn right and walk to the first cross roads .On this corner you will find a wine bar called the Ebury wine bar. Turn right at the wine bar into Ebury Street and walk about 100 meters you will find us on your right hand side.

Directions from Gatwick Express Platform at Victoria station

On arriving at Victoria find the lift or escalator that will take you up to street level .On exiting the station you will see a taxi rank in front of you from this point we are less than a 5 minute walk away .Turn right and walk down to the street . You then turn right and walk towards a major cross roads .Cross this junction walking pass a Starbucks coffee shop in to a street called Ecclestone Street , continue walking till you reach the next set of traffic lights/ cross roads . You then turn left in to Ebury Street .We are 100 metres on your left hand side.

Directions from Victoria Rail and Underground Station

Once you arrive at Victoria underground station follow signs to main train station. Go to the front of the station and Stand facing the station with buses and taxis behind you. You then turn right and walk towards the main road (Buckingham Palace Rd). On this road you turn left in to Buckingham Palace Rd and walk along the outside of the station until you come to a cross roads (the corner of the station). At this cross roads turn right in to Ecclestone street, you will see a Starbucks coffee shop on this corner. You walk to the next set of traffic lights. At this corner you turn left in to Ebury Street. We are 100 meters on your left hand side.

How to get to the Lynton Hotel from Waterloo train station.

General

You can get to us from Waterloo by bus, underground or taxi. Please also read the sheet about getting to us from Victoria coach, train and tube stations.

Bus

There is a direct bus route linking Waterloo and Victoria. You take the number 211 towards Hammersmith Broadway. Journey time is about 15 minutes and runs every 10 minutes and costs £1.50 . For The hotel you can get off the bus one stop after the station ,we are then less than a 5 minute walk . Visit www.tfl.gov.uk for more information.

Underground / Tube

Take a Jubilee tube one stop to Westminster you then change to a west bound district /circle line tube for two stops. A single fare is £3.00 and the journey takes about 10 minutes. We are then a 5 minute walk from the front of Victoria Station. Visit www.tfl.gov.uk for more information.

Taxi

If you have a lot of heavy luggage you may prefer to take a taxi directly to us. A black cab should not cost more than £12.00 unless there is particularly bad traffic.

Underground

Take a Jubilee line tube towards Stanmore and change at Westminster for either a circle or a district line tube going westbound to Victoria. A single fare is £3.00 and the journey takes about 15 minutes. We are then a 5 minute walk from the front of Victoria Station. Visit www.tfl.gov.uk for more information.

Taxi

If you have a lot of heavy luggage you may prefer to take a taxi direct to the B&B. A black cab should not cost more than £15.00 unless there is particularly bad traffic.

Bus

Take the Bus 436 towards Lewisham / The Lewisham Centre or Bus 36 towards New Cross Gate Bus Garage. Get off when you get to Victoria. You must pay before you board the bus. The journey time is about 25 minutes. Visit www.tfl.gov.uk for more information .

Underground / Tube

Take a Bakerloo line tube towards Elephant and Castle and change at Oxford Circus to a Victoria line tube towards Brixton to Victoria Station. A single fare is £3.00 and the journey takes about 15 minutes. Visit www.tfl.gov.uk for more information.

Taxi

If you have a lot of heavy luggage you may prefer to take a taxi direct to the B&B . A black cab should not cost more than £12.00 unless there is particularly bad traffic

Underground

From Kings Cross, St Pancras or Euston you take a Victoria line tube towards Brixton to Victoria station approximate journey time 10 minutes .We are a 5 minute walk from the front of the station .Visit www.tfl.gov.uk for more information .

General

You can get to us from Heathrow airport by tube, coach or taxi. Please also read the sheet about getting to us from Victoria coach, train and tube stations.

By underground or tube

If your luggage is light take the Piccadilly Line east bound. Change at Hammersmith to the District Line. Take the District Line train to Victoria which leaves from the same platform. Journey takes approximately 40 minutes and costs £4.00. Note that due to work on the Piccadilly line there is no underground service to Terminal 4 until September 2006. Passengers travelling to and from Terminal 4 can use the replacement bus between Hatton Cross underground station and Terminal 4. Visit www.tfl.gov.uk for more information.

By coach

From the central coach station located next to terminal 3 and close to terminals 1 and 2 take a national Express coach to Victoria coach station. Journey time 50 minutes cost £12.00. We advise this method if you have a lot of heavy luggage.

To transfer between the Terminal 4 and central bus station you can take the Heathrow Express free of charge. There is a lift from the underground walkway which leads from the Heathrow Express to the central bus station .

The central bus station is open 24 hours a day, and the travel centre is open from 06:00-22:30. The bus station is well sign posted from Terminals 1, 2 and 3 and is located above the London Underground station. Access to Terminals 1, 2 and 3 is via underground walkways. The approximate walking distance to Terminal 1 is four minutes, to Terminal 2 is three minutes and to Terminal 3 is seven minutes. Trolleys are provided nearby and there is a lift directly from the underground level to the central bus station. Please note that the last coach/bus from Heathrow is at 9.35pm. By taxi

If you have a lot of luggage you can take a black cab which will cost approximately £55.00. We can also arrange a pick up from the airport for around £40.00 depending on the size of the party and amount of luggage.

You can get to us from Gatwick by train, coach or taxi. Please also read the sheet about getting to us from Victoria coach, train and tube stations.

By train

You can take the direct train from Gatwick to Victoria station. The approximate journey time is 40 minutes. Trains start at about 03.30hrs and finish at 00.00hrs. From Victoria Station most of our customers just walk to the hotel (5 minutes). However if travelling with lots of luggage you may wish to take a taxi. The approximate cost is £6.00.

Tickets can be purchased from Gatwick Express's Ticket Offices at London Victoria and Gatwick Airport. Ticket Office opening times Mon - Sun: 06.15 - 20.45 closed between 09.15 - 09.45 and 18.00 - 18.30. Single fair £14.00 Return £25.00. Visit www.gatwickexpress.com for more information.

You can get to us from Stansted airport by train, coach or taxi. Please also read the sheet about getting to us from Victoria coach, train and tube stations.

By train

From Stansted you take the Stansted express to Tottenham Hale. Change here to the underground and take a Victoria line tube towards Brixton. Get off at Victoria station. The journey time is about 35 minutes to Tottenham Hale and 25 minutes to Victoria. This gives a total journey time of about 60 minutes.

The cost from Stansted to Tottenham Hale is £14.50 and the cost from Tottenham Hale to Victoria is £4.00. Visit www.StanstedExpress.com for more information.

By underground or tube

From Stansted you can take the National Express airbus direct to Victoria coach station. This is 2 minutes walk away from us. The approximate journey time 100 minutes and the cost is £10.00. Visit www.nationalexpress.com for more information

By train

From Luton Airport take a train to central London's King's Cross Thameslink station. Approximate journey time 35 minutes away from King's Cross and costs £12.00. From Kings Cross you take a Victoria line tube south bound to Victoria. Journey time 10 minutes and costs £3.00 . Visit www.tfl.gov.uk for more information .

By underground or tube

From Luton Airport take Green Line (Service 757) Terravision express coach to Victoria . The coach drops you of in Buckingham Palace Road .From the drop of point we are less than a 5 minute walk. Approximate journey time 90 minutes Single fare £10.50 Return £15.00. If you have a lot of luggage we advise this as the best option . Visit www.greenline.co.uk for more information

By taxi

You can get to Victoria from London City Airport by a combination of train and tube. Please also read the sheet about getting to us from Victoria coach, train and tube stations.

By tube and Docklands Light Railway (DLR)

From London City airport take the Docklands Light Railway directly to Canning Town, where you can pick up the Jubilee Line to Westminster. At Westminster you must change lines and take either the Circle or District Line to Victoria. Journey times are just 5 minutes into Canning Town and approximately 15 minutes into Westminster and 5 minutes to Victoria. Total time 25 minutes.

By taxi

If you have a lot of heavy luggage you may prefer to take a taxi directly to us. Journey time is about 45 minutes and costs approximately £25.00.

By train
